Eide Bailly 2017 Audit Engagement Letter

City Administrator Jesse Dickson presented the Eide Bailly 2017 Audit Engagement Letter. Dickson reported this coming year will be new auditors from previous years and asked if now would be the time to change. Councilmember Sarah Bruss recommended staying with Eide Bailly this year and then next fall start shopping around.

Bolton & Menk - Conrad Ave Reconstruction Project Award

Jake Saulsbury, Bolton & Menk reviewed the bids received for the Conrad Avenue Reconstruction Project

Jake Saulsbury reported after the bid opening Olson Construction, Excavation and Utility Company formally requested their bid be withdrawn from the received bids. This is allowed per the contract documents within 24 hours after bids are opened if the bidder demonstrates that there was a material and substantial mistake in the preparation of its bids. The next lowest bid was R & R Excavating, Inc. at \$379,554.74 and was 17.5% below the engineer's estimated amount of \$460,000.00.

Motion by Meyer to accept the \$379,554.74 bid from from R & R Excavating, Inc for Conrad Ave Reconstruction Project seconded by Szaroletta. Motion passed unanimously.
