ADOPT AGENDA

COUNCIL BUSINESS

a) City Administrator Update

Mayor Matt Lein updated the Council on the background check for City Administrator candidate Brian Beeman. The personnel committee reported there were concerns regarding the information received from the City of Melrose regarding Mr. Beeman's performance reviews. Councilmember and personnel committee member Jill Skaaland reported she had communicated with Mr. Beeman and found some conflicting answers to her questions. After some discussion the Council recommended rescinding the job offer to Mr. Beeman.

b) Springsted, Inc., Terry Heaton Refunding Bonds

Terry Heaton from Springsted, Inc. recommended proceeding with the refunding of city bonds. Ms. Heaton reported the city is rated at A2, which is considered favorable.

Motion by Meyer, seconded by McInnis to approve a sign permit for the Cologne Fire Relief Association. Motion passed unanimously.
