




**CITY OF COLOGNE  
RESOLUTION NO. 18-19  
A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE COMPLETION OF A FEASIBILITY STUDY  
FOR THE STREET & UTILITY RECONSTRUCTION PROJECT**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Cologne recognizes the need to improve its street and utility infrastructure; and


**WHEREAS**, the City of Cologne proposes to reconstruct the street, storm sewer, and municipal utilities of all city owned streets located north of T.H. 212, east of T.H. 284 (Paul Avenue), and south of Benton Street East, and to assess the benefited properties for a portion of the cost of the improvement, pursuant to Minnesota Statutes, Chapter 429; and

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the City Council of the City of Cologne, Minnesota, that the proposed improvement, called the Street & Utility Reconstruction Project be referred to the City Engineer for study and that that person is instructed to report to the council with all convenient speed advising the council in a preliminary way as to whether the proposed improvement is necessary, cost-effective, and feasible; whether it should best be made as proposed or in connection with some other improvement; the estimated cost of the improvement as recommended; and a description of the methodology used to calculate individual assessments for affected parcels.
